DECEMBER 12th

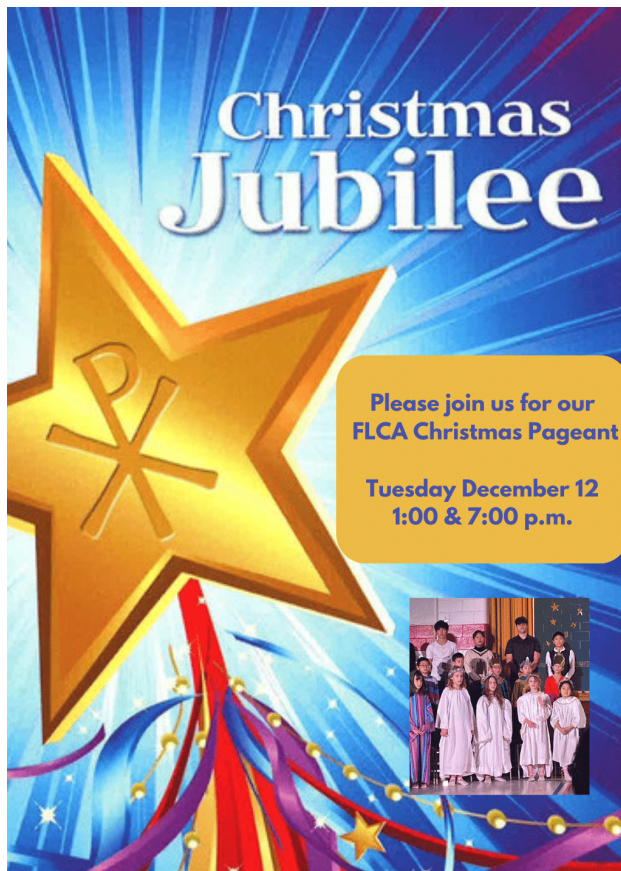
