\*Kindergarten Half-Day students may stay with us through lunch for the pageant or may go home. If they leave, we ask that they return by 12:30pm to prepare.


Dress for the EVENING performance: We ask that the children come dressed in their "Christmas Best" (no jeans please.)

A large box is set up in the front lobby next to our Giving Tree. The Unemployment Help Centre is collecting coats of all sizes, along with hats and gloves.




New and used coats are welcome! The Giving Tree gifts should be brought to school by December 7th. Thank you for
