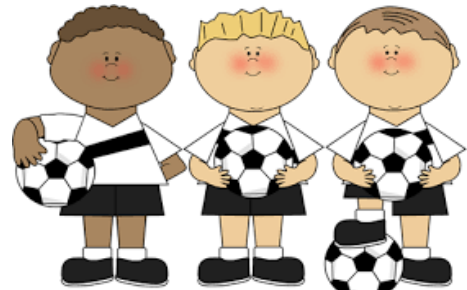
HOT LUNCH REMINDER
