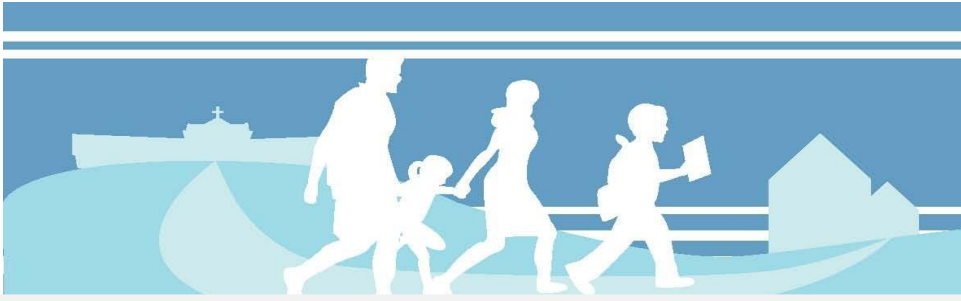

It has pleased Almighty God to call unto Himself, the soul of our beloved founding Principal, Mr. Frank Johnson. Mr. Johnson was also the father of our Grade 7 / 8 teacher, Mrs. Christine Keech, the father-in-law of Kindergarten teacher, Mrs. Jennifer Johnson, and grandfather of our alumni, Indica Keech ('12), Evan Johnson ('13) and Grace Johnson ('16).

Mr. Johnson worked tirelessly to found our school, from the purchase of the property, through the set up of the Board of Directors, the incorporation of the school, the hiring of staff, the selection of curriculum, the writing of by-laws, the purchase of furniture and supplies and countless other details and hours and hours of meetings. Throughout it all, he set the very high standard by which he expected the school to be run and governed.

Most importantly, he led by example, praying, teaching and ensuring that everything he did was based on the Word of God. He modelled expected behaviour and fostered the partnership between Church, Home and School, which has resulted in 22 years of blessings. It is impossible to measure the impact of his teaching and leadership. We know, that through the Holy Spirit, Mr. Johnson helped to share the saving news of the gospel of Jesus Christ with many, many students and their families. We thank God for the life of His good and faithful servant.
