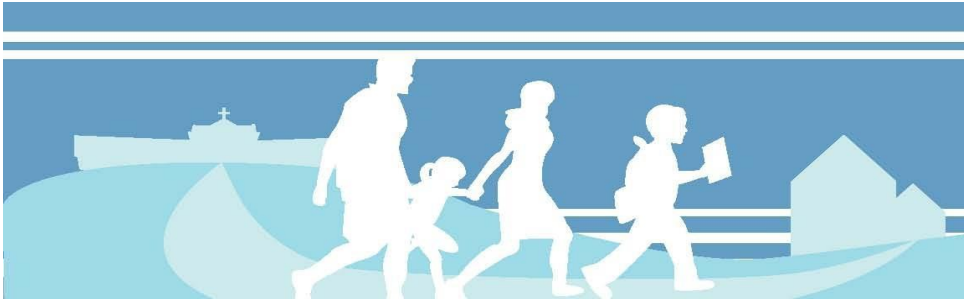

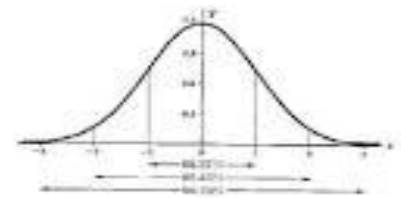

- Building event apparatus

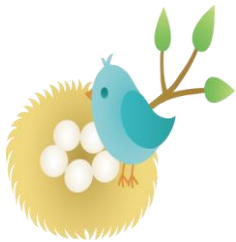
