

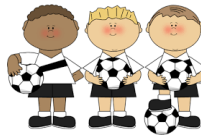

ABOUT OCTOBER 31ST

Did you know that October 31st is the birthday of the Lutheran church, indeed of all Protestant churches? Dr. Martin Luther chose All Hallows' Eve (the night before All Saints' Day) to nail his 95 theses to the door of the castle church at Wittenberg. This year is very special because it is the 500th anniversary of that day in October of 1517. We commemorate this important day in the history of the church with special services and we will certainly celebrate Reformation Day here at FLCA as well.
