MRS. LUTHER

When Martin Luther was 42, he married a 26-year-old former Cistercian nun, Katharina von Bora. They had a happy and affectionate marriage and she bore six children.

Unusually for the time, Mrs. Luther not only ran her household and managed family finances, but also ran a guest house in the former Wittenberg monastery, served as liaison with Luther's publishers and was also known for her intellect (Luther called her "Doctora Lutherin"). Although some feared Luther's decision to support married clergy, Luther said his marriage would cause "the angels to laugh and the devils to weep." The Luther family placed great emphasis on the importance of family devotions, participating in daily prayers, hymn singing and Bible readings. It is good that we remember this amazing woman and her part in the Reformation.
