#### CHRISTMAS PAGEANT DETAILS.....

Please come and celebrate with us as we worship the Christ Child in song and scripture. Our 23rd annual Christmas Pageant, "Joy to the World" will be held on Tuesday, December 12th, with performances at 1:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. In addition to our pageant, which involves all the children from Grades 1 to 8, the PK/JK/SK class has prepared a few selections and our Grade 6 and our Grade 7/8 bands will play. Our strong hope is that all students will be present in both performances - we need them.

Dress for the afternoon performance for those children in Grade 1 to Grade 8, consists of their "best" school **uniform**. We'll work with the children that day to help them remain clean and fresh looking throughout their recesses.

Parking and seating for our evening performance always present a special challenge ... our cast seems to be very popular! We will attempt to provide as much seating as possible; please allow enough time to "park and walk", so that you can enjoy the opening selections. Please do not leave valuables in your car; we don't want to encourage "break-ins". There are usually extra seats at our afternoon performance ... perhaps that time fits your schedule.

There will be no hot lunch on that day. Since the Gym (where we usually eat lunch) will be set for the performance, we will eat lunch in our classrooms on Tuesday. The kitchen will be closed, so every child needs to bring a bagged lunch to eat and a drink thus minimizing cleanup in the classrooms following lunch.

We ask that the children come to the evening performance dressed in their "Christmas Best". (no jeans, please.) Pupils should arrive at the school for the evening performance at 6:30 sharp and proceed to their classrooms, so that we can begin the performance right on time. Please help us to ensure that the children are appropriately dressed. If you come earlier, would you please keep your children with you until 6:15 p.m., when their teachers will be able to supervise them in their classrooms.

**Special PK/JK/SK Note**: During the evening pageant, after the children in PK/JK/SK have finished their performance, we will be sending them to sit with their parents so that they have an opportunity to see the pageant too. You might like to save a spot for them.
