PRE-KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

Under current legislation, we are limited to five spaces in our Pre-Kindergarten programme again for 2018-2019. Pre-Kindergarten students at FLCA are at least 2.5 years of age and toilet trained (So for 2018-2019, this could apply to children born in 2015 and 2016).
