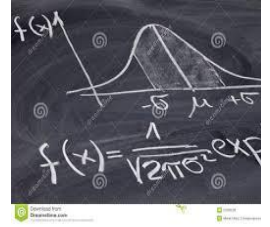
PLEASE SUPPORT OUR TRIP TO STRATFORD
