FLOOR HOCKEY

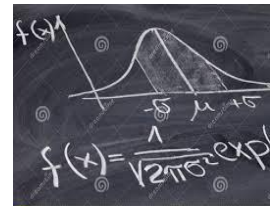


Today our teams are participating in the WECSA Floor Hockey Tournament at Maranatha Christian Academy. Go Eagles!
