The Lego Robotics Club will meet today after school, from 3:30 – 5:00 p.m.



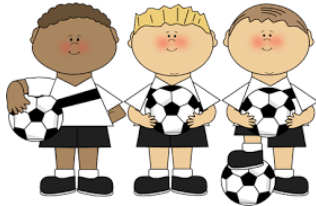
RAFFLE PRIZES
