Students should bring a lunch from home and lunches will be eaten in individual classrooms.



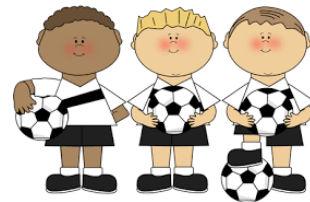
