## TIME AND TARDINESS

Every new year brings with it a time when many people resolve to do things better; exercise more, get more sleep, eat better, etc. Can we add a plea for one more resolution? Let's all do our very best not to be tardy in the morning. It seems as if the traffic volume in Windsor has worsened and we know our families are very busy, but we have noticed an increasing number of children are late for school and also late for Chapel. While you may think that it is okay if it is "only once in a while", the cumulative effect of this lateness is more disruptive than you might imagine.

It is important for us that we begin the day with prayer, asking God to bless our students and their studies each day. Even if only a few minutes behind, students are missing this corporate prayer time, announcements, the singing of the national anthem, as well as important introductory parts of lessons and administrative work (attendance, lunch sign ups, agenda updates etc.) disrupting the class and causing the teacher to repeat missed information. Students who arrive in a timely fashion have an opportunity to prepare calmly for their days; putting things away in their lockers, placing needed items on their desks, quietly greeting their friends rather than rushing in frantically and then trying to play "catch up".



One way to go about affecting this change is to work on another "resolution". Prayer and time management seem to go hand-in-hand. While it may seem counterintuitive to claim that praying more gives you more time for other things, it works because we are asking God who has given us all of our days, to bless the way we spend that time. Making a conscious effort to increase our prayer time has a positive spill-over effect in our daily lives. God listens to our prayers and He will continue to bless us daily. Let's remember to give Him thanks and praise, for our families and school, and for His grace and forgiveness.

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
