Raffles are always a popular event and an excellent way to raise funds. Even if you are not able to attend, perhaps you would consider donating a prize.



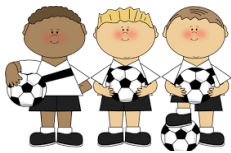

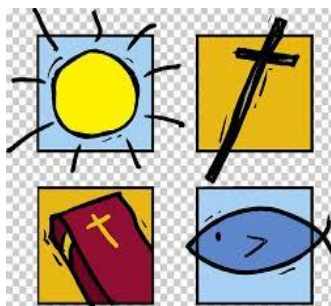

A SPECIAL NOTE ABOUT OUR PARKING LOT

We ask our drivers to be vigilant about children and parents walking to their cars during dismissal time. Only drop children off in the drop zone so that other drivers may exit parking spots without fear of striking children. Please leave the centre laneway free for those trying to exit and enter.
