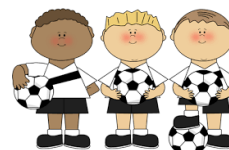

## ABOUT OCTOBER 31<sup>ST</sup>



Did you know that October 31<sup>st</sup> is the birthday of the Lutheran church, indeed of all Protestant churches? Dr. Martin Luther chose All Hallows' Eve (the night before All Saints' Day) to nail his 95 theses to the door of the castle church at Wittenberg, an event many cite as the beginning of the Reformation. We commemorate this important day in the history of the church with special services and we will certainly celebrate Reformation Day here at FLCA as well. We have deliberately chosen to downplay Hallowe'en at FLCA, with its emphasis on witches, ghosts and the like.
