## 2019 INCOME TAX RECEIPTS

Beginning tomorrow, income tax receipts will be available for pick-up in the Academy office. Unclaimed receipts will be placed in the mail on

**Friday, February 21**<sup>st</sup>. Every year at this time, we have questions from parents regarding the nature of tax receipts issued by FLCA; particularly those involving portions of tuition paid which may be eligible for consideration as donations. Simply stated, the Canada Revenue Agency allows private schools to issue tuition tax receipts according to the following policy:

"A private school that is registered as a charity and offers both secular and religious education, at the elementary or secondary school level, can only issue an official donation receipt to the parents or guardian of a student for the religious education."

In order to determine the amount of the tuition paid which is eligible as above, the yearly cost of the secular (non-religious) portion of instruction is calculated according to CRA guidelines. The difference between the tuition paid in the calendar year (minus any payments for preschool, childcare or before and after school care which are receipted in full) and the "family cost" of secular education is then eligible to be issued as a donation receipt for religious education.



Please note that the largest receiptable amounts are generated for "first or only" children in a family, since they are invoiced at the full tuition amount. "Second and subsequent" children in a family are invoiced at 65% of the tuition rate, thus minimizing the difference between tuition paid and the actual cost of secular education (which is the same for all students). While the receiptable amount is less in this case, the family benefits at the outset by the reduced tuition rate.

You will receive several receipts in your package this year:

- a) Tuition Donation Receipt
- b) Tuition Paid Receipt
- c) Child Care Receipt
- d) Before and After School Care Receipt
- e) Donation Receipt (if applicable)
- f) Readathon Donation Receipt (if applicable)


