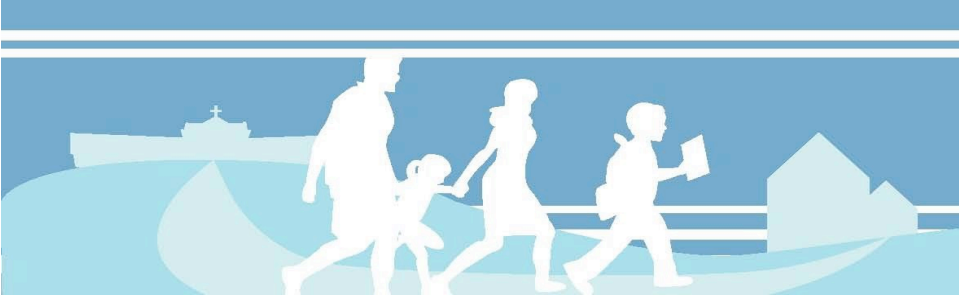

## OUR FLCA FAMILY

## FLCA CROSS COUNTRY MEET

Implementing our COVID-19 mitigation plan means that many of the special activities that we do together as a school or on school teams will have to wait for a while. **However, we have made some changes to our FLCA Cross Country Meet which we believe will allow us to operate under the mitigation guidelines. We will hold our meet at Roseland Park on Thursday, October 8 beginning at 9am** with our Primary 1K (Gr 1 and Gr 2/3), then our Junior 2K (Gr 4/5 and Gr 6), followed by our Senior 3K (Gr 7 and Gr 8). We've worked out ways to run the meet without volunteers and keeping the members of our class cohorts separated. **Spectators may watch from the sidewalk across the street from the park.**

As we do every year, the day of the meet will be an out of uniform day. Students should come to school wearing what they plan to run in, as we are not able to access the change rooms. It might be a good idea to send an extra pair of socks and shoes, as the grass at the park can be a little wet in the morning. **Go Eagles!**

## DAILY COVID-19 SCREENING

The Windsor Essex County Health Unit is now recommending an **interactive COVID-19 Daily Screening Tool** for use by parents, students, staff and school visitors. To make it easier for you, there is a link on the **Home** page of our website at [www.flca.ca](http://www.flca.ca). There is additional information included in this tool to help you make decisions about whether to send your child to school and what your next steps should be in the event of illness. As many of you have noticed, the screening tool has been revised since October 1, with a different grouping of symptoms and more advice about what to do.

**All FLCA Staff and students must use the screening tool daily before coming to school.**
