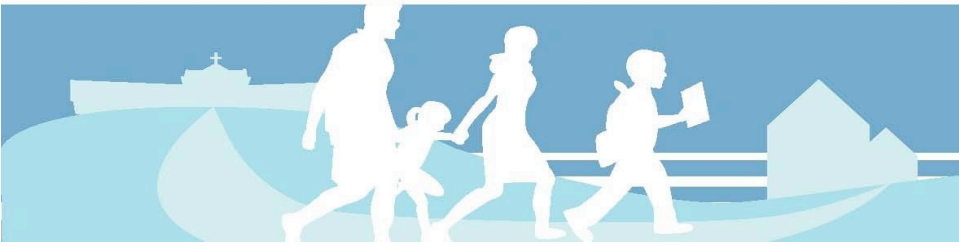


# Tuesday Note
