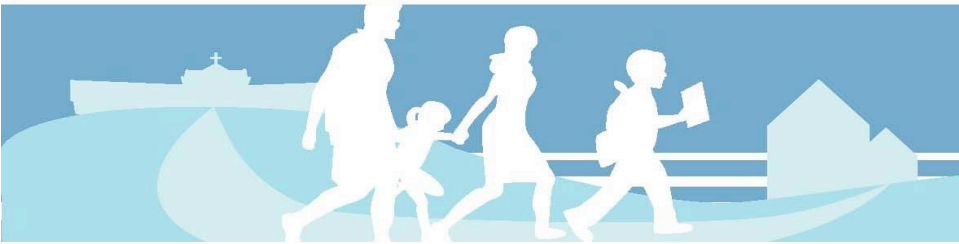

WE HAVE AIR PURIFIERS!

Through a generous donation by one of our school families, there are now air purifier units with HEPA/charcoal filters in each of our classrooms! This gives us one more layer of protection from aerosol spread in conjunction with our current practice of opening windows and doors periodically throughout the day in order to facilitate complete air exchange, even as the temperatures outside fall. **It's still very important to make sure that all students come to school with a sweater, or sweatshirt that they can put on in the classroom, if needed.** It is best that students keep these items in their backpacks or wear them all day as access to their lockers will still be restricted except upon arrival and at dismissal. As well, our nighttime cleaning protocols prohibit the storage of these items overnight in the classrooms.

As many of you have noticed, the screening tool has been revised since October 1, with a different grouping of symptoms and more advice about what to do. **In addition, the WECHU has published a flow chart (included with this Tuesday Note), which clearly outlines their protocol for Students with any Symptoms of COVID-19.**
