DAILY COVID-19 SCREENING

The Windsor Essex County Health Unit is recommending an interactive COVID-19 Daily Screening Tool for use by parents, students, staff and school visitors. To make it easier for you, there is a link on the Home page of our website at www.flca.ca. The screening tool indicates different groupings of symptoms and gives advice about next steps. In addition, the WECHU has published a flow chart (included with this Tuesday Note), which clearly outlines their protocol for Students With Any Symptoms of COVID-19.

All FLCA staff and students must use the screening tool daily before coming to school each morning.

SCHOOL CLOSURES DUE TO INCLEMENT WEATHER - "SNOW DAYS"

In the event of an emergency (loss of heat during the night, weather so inclement that it would be dangerous for students and staff to travel), school will be closed. This year, you will be notified via email as early as possible in the morning by your child's teacher. Notification will also be given on the school voicemail as well as on area radio stations. If we do declare a rare "snow day", there will be no school for those attending in school classes as well as those learning from home.
