Basketball Tryouts continue this Wednesday from 3:00-4:00pm.

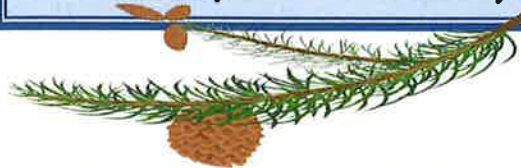
There will be no Tryouts next week because of the Christmas Pageant.
