## Time and Tardiness

Every new year brings with it a time when many people resolve to do things better; exercise more, get more sleep, eat better, etc. Can we add a plea for one more resolution? Let's all do our very best not to be tardy in the morning. It seems as if traffic volume in Windsor has worsened and we know our families are very busy, but we have noticed an increased number of children are late for school and also for Chapel. While you may think that it is okay if it is "only once in a while" the cumulative effect of this lateness is more disruptive than you might imagine.
