## Government offers "Catch-up" payments

 The Ontario government launched Catch Up Payments, offering families direct financial aid to support their children as they catch up. This money can be used to help to offset costs, whether that be for educational supplies, additional tutoring supports or other items to help their children address learning needs resulting from the pandemic.Students (up to 18 years old) can receive $\$ 200$ per child, while students with special education needs (up to 21 years old) can receive $\$ 250$. Families can apply for Catch Up Payments through a secure CRA website where they can create a unique profile for each eligible student.
